- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

L5 - 1/4 corner common to sections 12 & 13, T19N, R1W

Found no evidence of GLO. Found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " smooth iron bar at base of corner fence post, as used by Ostling in his 1984 survey in section 13. Also found a $\frac{1}{2}$ " CIR #27458 per LCRC page C679 12' East. $\frac{1}{2}$ " smooth iron bar is located 87'± North and 224'± East of Sugar River, and fits the Ostling monumentation of the North-South $\frac{1}{4}$ line. Accepted $\frac{1}{2}$ " smooth iron bar as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner, and replaced it with a 4" DNR aluminum cap on 1" x 36" long galvanized iron pipe.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

<u>L5</u> – 4" DNR aluminum cap on 1" x 36" long galvanized iron pipe. – Set Blue Post 1' Northeast.
