

Original survey by Algernon Merryweather in June - July 1852. Original corner: Cedar 12" diameter corner tree at 62.66 chains South Original bearing tree: Cedar 7" diameter bears N 60°W a distance of 8 links.

1981 survey by Genisot Associates.

B. Description of corner evidence found and / or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

I found a 1" iron pipe as shown on the 1981 survey by Genisot Associates. Distances check relatively close with map dimensions. Record research on file.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I accepted the 1" iron pipe and replaced it with a stamped standard aluminum Bernsten monument with 4 foot aluminum rod approximately 30 feet South of the shoreline of Poor Lake. I established the following witnesses:
