East Meander corner between Sections 27 and 34.

I, Gary L. Pisoni, in a field survey on December 18, 1993, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by Algernon Merryweather, U.S. Deputy Surveyor on June 14, 1852.  
Original corner: 12" Hemlock corner tree  
Original Bearing Tree:

Cedar 6" North 9 links (5.94 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence remains of original corner or bearing tree. Corner position found marked by a 1/2" iron pipe and angle iron located on the East shore of Clearwater Lake. Iron pipe set by unknown person. I accept the iron pipe and angle iron as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Replaced 1/2" pipe and angle iron with a 2" diameter by 30" long split base aluminum pipe monument with a 3" cast aluminum cap, stamped to read: T45N, R41W, M.C., S-27, S-34, 1991, RLS- 27457 from which I established the following new bearing trees:  
(all measurements taken to a nail in side of tree)
