Recovered the 1928 standard brass capped concrete monument as described in Harringtons notes. His B.T. at N.03 W. is now a 14-16" decayed Cedar windfall. His B.T. at S.58-30 W. is now a live 15" Red Maple with 1928 blaze grown over.

A Hemlock stump at N.63 E. and a stump hole with fragments of decayed Hemlock wood and bark still remain from Burts 1847 B.T.s.
