I, Richard L. Drahn in a field survey on June 21, 19 97,
do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned
in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the
current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land
Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5
above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a
Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as
expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt in 1847. Original B.T.s --- Hemlock 7"
N.74 E. 66 links (43.56') --- Cedar 8" S.76 W. 18 links (11.88') ---

Corner restored by Earl Harrington in 1928 from the original (18") scribed
Cedar B.T. He set a standard State Line concrete, brass capped monument
and established two new B.T.s. --- Cedar 18" North 8.6 ft. --- Cedar 15"
S.49-30 E. 7.3 ft. ---

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Recovered the standard brass capped concrete monument as described in Earl
Harrington's notes. His B.T. North 8.6' is now a 19" Cedar windfall with
scribing visible. His B.T. at S.49-30 E. is now a large badly decayed
Cedar windfall.

William Burts Cedar B.T. is now a downed, badly decayed Cedar. No
evidence remains of his Hemlock B.T.
