Richard L. Drahn in a field survey on September 30, 19 97 do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Corner established by William Burt in 1847. Original B.T.s --- Y. Birch 14" N.03 W. 22 links (14.52') --- Cedar 10" S.26 E. 7 links (4.62') ---

Corner restored By Earl Harrington in 1928 from the remains of the two original B.T.s. The Cedar B.T. was recovered at $\underline{S.26~W.}$ He set a standard brass capped concrete monument and two new B.T.s. --- Spruce 12" N.64-40 E. 22.1' --- Hemlock 14" $\underline{S.37~W.}$ 25.7'.

Daniel K. Pleoger (Wisc. No. S-1537) recovered the concrete monument and the remains of the 1928 B.T.s. He established the following new B.T.s: B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

--- 5" (6") Yellow Birch N.60 W. (N.59 W.) 35.73' (35.92') --- 13" (12") Yellow Birch N.46 E. (N.48 E.) 38.30' (38.47') --- 8" (8") Balsam N.65 E. (N.65 E.) 15.88' (15.82') --- 6" (7") Yellow Birch S.35 W. (S.38 W.) 5.60' (5.64') ---

I recovered the 1928 standard brass capped concrete monument and the decayed stumps of the two 1928 B.T.s. The Hemlock stump, still scribed was recovered at $\underline{\text{S.37 E.}}$ rather then at $\underline{\text{S.37 W.}}$ I recovered D.K. Pleogers B.T.s as described in parentheses above.

No evidence remains of the 1847 B.T.s.
