A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I reestablished the corner position by extending the section line common to Sections 16 and 21 until intersecting the bank of the Montreal River. I was able to set a point on line 362.14 feet east of said meander corner and actually run true line to river and by doing so were able to find an ancient fence line on our true line. I have determined that this is the best and most probable location for the corner position.
