- USDA Form 874-9 dated 3/29/35 No corner found. States corner location at road intersections. Found 6" maple with tag from which this corner bears S.W. - 66.0 feet.
- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I verified the corner position with measurements from existing corners and is positioned on centerline intersection of a N-S paved road, a gravel road running west and a trail running east.

I found U.S.F.S. tag in 12" B. ash bearing N55°W - 48.28 feet.

Record research on file with Register of Deeds.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate localing that

I set a 3 1/4" diameter brass cap stamped: T48N, R47W; S-16; S-15; S-21; S-22; 1995; RLS 28410, from which I established the following bearing trees and reference objects: 6" twin hemlock - S56°E, 50.58 feet; 8" balsam fir - S55°W, 51.16 feet; 12" black ash - N55°W, 48.28 feet; a reference monument consisting of a 2 1/2" diameter x 30" long aluminum pipe with a 3 1/4" aluminum cap stamped: County Remonumentation; T48N, R47W; R.M.; S-15; S-16; S-21; S-22; 1995; RLS 28410; S65°W, 37.48 feet; a 6 foot steel rail with sign - 0.84 feet away.
