A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established by William Ives on August 14, 1848. Set post. Original bearing trees: Hemlock 18" S 39° E 10 links Cedar 10" S 52° W 10 links

John R. Garske on line and 116 feet north of 1/4 corner set a 2" galvanized iron pipe with brass cap. Garske recorded said corner in Liber 2 page 132 of Land Corners for Gogebic County. The following reference objects were established. 6" W. Birch- N 72° W-9.17'; 8" W. Birch- N 80° E- 8.91'.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

I found the 2" galvanized iron pipe with 2" brass cap as noted in John R. Garske certification and it checked with the witnesses in John R. Garske certification. I updated the corner monument and accessories as noted below to state and county specification.
