

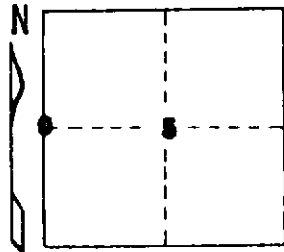

Found U.S. corner identified by H. F. Northrup, County Surveyor in 1889, and by C. P. Tuller in 1907. Found 1 1/4" pipe in cement in place. Replaced with above described Dept. Monument.
