I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on I3 03/07/2008 do hereby state
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(I3) Corner common to Sections 2-3-10-11. 1969 - Reestablished by A.O.Enger RLS by double
proportionate measurement to the original record between section corners 1 mile N, 1 mile S, 1 mile
E, and 2 miles W. Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with 4" aluminum cap. Sugar Maple 7 S30E 73 links, Red Maple
4 S19W 26 links, Balsam 7 N13W 42.5 links.

(J3) Quarter corner common to Sections 2 and 11. 1969 - Corner reestablished by A.O.Enger RLS,
midway and on line between Section corners 39.84 chains to east and west. Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with
4" aluminum cap. Red Maple 5 N85 1/2W 25.5 links, Red Maple 4 N88E 9.5 links, Aspen 6 N57E 25.5
links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(I3) Found the 1969 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the remaining
NBTs Sugar Maple SE and Red Maple SW, both in good condition with overgrown blazes. The Balsam NBT
was not recovered. The position of the monument is S32E 10.7' from the double proportionate position
as I calculate it from my measurements to the Section corner control noted in Section A, above. I
accept the monument as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

(J3) Found the 1969 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the Red Maple
NBTs. The Red Maple NBT NW is standing dead. Any evidence of the Aspen NBT was obscured by snow
cover. My measurements show the monument to be located 5.0' East and 0.3' North of the midway
position of record and I accept same as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the
original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(I3) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
8" Sugar S37E 48.7' old blazes (1969 NBT)
7" Maple S23W 17.3' do do
7" Maple N72E 10.0' mrkd "S2 NBT"
5" Sugar S59W 9.8' "S10 NBT"
Set sq'd spruce post adjacent. Bearings magnetic. Set sq'd post adjacent. Bearings magnetic.

(J3) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MDNR cap.
Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of:
4" Maple S89E 6.1' old blazes (1969 NBT)
4" Maple S33W 8.1' mrkd "1/4S NBT"
6" Maple S81W 18.6' do
3" Sugar N43W 10.8' do
Set sq'd spruce post adjacent. Bearings magnetic. Set sq'd post adjacent. Bearings magnetic.
