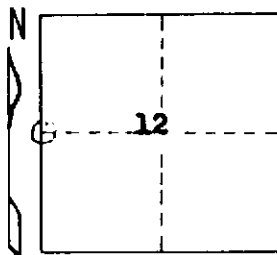

DESCRIPTION OF CORNER 1/4 corner between Sections 11 and 12
CORNER MONUMENT 1" I.D. x 36" iron pipe with 4" aluminum cap
DATE MONUMENT PLACED AND WITNESSED July 28, 1969
WITNESSES TO CORNER..... W. Spruce 12 S65°W 82½ lks. "1/4S, NBT"

DESCRIPTION IN DETAIL AS TO HOW CORNER WAS LOCATED AND IDENTIFIED OR RESTORED.

Monument placed on an old E & W fence line 1.45 chains East of an old fence corner. The undersigned believes that the fence corner itself is not the original location of the 1/4 post, because of lack of harmony with stream crossings along the section line and with other old fences north and south of this corner. This fence was found to be 119.94 chains south of an original corner on the north township boundary, or 0.85 chains shorter than the record distance of 120.79 chains.

The aforementioned E & W fence line is mentioned in Corner Record of B. D. Buckler, dated 6/3/1966, as being about 2 chains north (actually 1.80 chains) of his calculated corner position. This places his corner 121.74 chains South of the original corner on the north township boundary, or 0.95 chains longer than record. Measurements along section lines between Sec. 10 & 11 and 2 & 3, as established by proportionate measure from original corners, indicate a distance of 158.34 chains, or 1.36 chains shorter than the record of 159.70 chains; similarly, distances on section lines between Sec. 9 & 10 and 3 & 4 show 159.10 chains, or 1.56 chains shorter than the record 160.66 chains.
