(C6) Quarter corner common to Sections 17 and 18. 1959 - Reestablished by Billy D. Buckler RLS midway and on line between Section corners. Set 1" I.D. I.pipe with 4" brass cap. 11" White Pine N52E 40 links, 6" Sugar Maple S54W 14 links.

(B5) Quarter corner common to Sections 7 and 18. 1959 - Remonumented by Billy D. Buckler RLS from stump of Hemlock B.T. N85E 08 links, in poor condition, scribing plain. Set 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. 20" Cedar S89E 52 links, 22" Sugar Maple S19W 5.5 links.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(C6) Found the 1959 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1959 witnesses, both in good condition. Measured to Section corners north and south to verify the position of the monument and accepted same as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
