I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 01/30/13 do hereby state  
that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2  
above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey  
instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of  
a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with  
the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established,  
re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded  
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K2) Quarter corner common to Sections 1-2. 1970 - A.O.Enger RLS remonumented the corner in the  
original position at record bearing and distance from an original BT W.Pine 24" S87E 5 links, a  
stump in good condition with scribe marks "1/4S" and "BT". Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with 4" alum. cap.  
Red Maple 6" S38W 5.0', Red Maple 4" N02W 6.0'.

(L3) Quarter corner common to Sections 1-12. 1970 - Reestablished by A.O.Enger RLS by proportionate  
measurement to the original record between Section corners. Set 1"IDx36" I.pipe with 4" alum. cap.  
Sugar Maple 10" N25W 12.5', Hemlock 6" S75E 16.0'. Squared and scribed an Oak N5W 3 ft. from  
corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K2) The 1970 monument was recovered in good condition and at record bearing and distance from one  
1970 NBT: The Red Maple 4" N02W 6.0' is in good condition with overgrown blazes. The stump of the  
OBT W.Pine is present at record bearing and distance but all traces of scribing have rotted away.  
Accepted the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

(L3) The 1970 monument was recovered in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the  
Hemlock SE and from the Oak N5W, both in good condition. In spite of the 1970 record, the Oak N5W  
shows no sign of having been squared and scribed (probably due to its vigorous growth). The  
monument was found substantially at the proportionate position between Section corners and is  
accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(K2) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MI Dept. of  
Conservation cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag  
in the side of:  
9" Maple N04E 6.2' old blazes (1970 NBT)  
12" Maple S61E 9.95' mrkd "1/4S NBT"  
5" Sugar S10W 14.0' do  
4" Sugar N71W 7.4' do  
Set sq'd cedar post adjacent.

(L3) Found 1"ID I.pipe with 4" alum. MI Dept of  
Conservation cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR  
tag in the side of:  
12" Hemlock S70E 16.0' old blazes (1970 NBT)  
16" Oak N02W 2.95' mrkd "1/4S NBT" do  
9" Sugar S03E 6.2' do  
6" Maple S63W 10.75' do  
Set sq'd cedar post adjacent.
