I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on 7 10/08/15 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(K13) Standard Section corner common to Sections 35-36. 1845 - W.A.Burt set post. Cedar 16" N24°E 32 links, Cedar 8" N35°W 37 links. Notes of P.A. & M.C. Larsen for Closing Cor. K1 of T52N-R35W: "1920 - Found old cedar post. 1958 - Set new post along side.". 1966 - Billy D. Buckler RLS: Replaced corner as set by M.C. Larsen, Hancock. Found no original witnesses. 1" pipe with 4" aluminum cap. 14" Cedar N50°E 31.7', 12" Cedar S85°W 31.5', 6" Soft Maple South 17.6'. The 1966 record erroneously describes the Closing Corner as being common to Standard Corner K13. According to the US survey, the Standard Corner is 06 links east of the Closing Corner.

(7-Sec. 36) North 1/16 corner between Section 36 T53N-R35W and Section 31 T53N-R34W. 1922 notes of Fesing show "ced. post" 1322.5' south of Section corner and 1322.5' north of 1/4 corner.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(K13) Found two rotted-off post points at substantial record bearing and distance from the 1966 witnesses, corresponding to the Closing Corner between 1 & 2. Reestablished the position of the Standard Corner K13 3.96' east of the post points, on a line between them and the Township corner. From the position thus established, I found a rotted Cedar stump, no marks, likely the remains of the original BT Cedar N35°W 37 links, at substantial record bearing and distance.

(7-Sec. 36) Found no evidence of prior monumentation at the corner position. Established the position for the corner midway and on the Range line between Section corner 1326.22' north and Quarter corner 1326.22' south. The monument installed leans E'ly 0.2'+/- due to subsurface roots and rock. The top center of the cap marks the corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(K13) Set 1"IDx28" I.pipe with 2" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of: 12" Cedar N50°E 29.0' old blazes (1966 wit. tree) 10" Maple S18°W 17.4' do do 15" Cedar N88°W 35.15' do do 10" Spruce S67°E 12.65' mrkd "S1 NBT" 1"ID I.pipe/MDNR cap at Closing cor. N87°W 3.96' Set sq'd cedar post 1 ft. north. E= 7870557.363 N= 240950.489

(7) Set 1"IDx28" I.pipe with 2" alum. MDNR cap. Set measuring nail with MDNR tag in the side of: 8" Maple N04°E 23.35' mrkd "1/16S BT" 8" Cedar N83°E 18.75' do 6" Maple in clump S48°E 3.25' do 5" Maple S80°W 17.7' do Set sq'd cedar post adjacent. E= 7872200.778 N= 242129.754
