Corner B, C-13 is the meander corner on the E. shore of Portage Lake, on section line
(also Township line) common to Section 31, T55N, R32W & Section 6, T54N, R32W.

I, Michael T. Drewyor, in a field survey on December 4, 19 97 do hereby
state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines
1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current
manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land
Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and
5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree
of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded
on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Meander Corner - At 74.75 chains (meas. Trigonometrically from W), course of
coast S4E & N15E, set meander post.

White Pine 28, S 11° E, 21

No evidence of original monument or accessories found. This line was originally surveyed by Deputy Surveyor William Ives between
July 13, 1845 & July 24, 1845.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Meander Corner - In 1967, Charles Hein, RLS 13034 shows this meander corner in place 274.68 feet West of the SE corner of
Section 31. I retraced Chuck's survey & found the meander corner as called for. Found 1" solid iron rod 7" below grade, iron rod
bent Southerly. This corner is located on the West side of the house at Fire No. 139 on Bootjack Road.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

All witness points in trees are PK nails and washers.

Meander Corner - Found 1" iron rod (description above).
