A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original Government Survey by William Brookfield, 1825: Beech 10" S. 49½° W. 24 links; Beech 13" N. 36½° W. 8 links.

Records of Ringenberg, no date (A.J. Hatt): Iron pipe; poplar N.W. 42.85'; 3" stump fence corner East 31.5'; power pole S.E. 68.6'.B.

This corner was recovered by J.E. Maxson in August 1995 and prior to paving of Hillsdale Road a monument box was set by contractor.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

On 9-16-97 I found a 3/4" iron rod in monument box in centerline Hillsdale Road.

No witnesses were found.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

I set County remonumentation cap on 3/4" iron rod in the monument box and is accepted as best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

In centerline Hillsdale Road.

Found P.K. N. side power pole S. 78° E. 30.41'

Found 60D spike w/ribbon S. side R.R. tie anch. post N. 63° W. 36.00'

Found P.K. E. side power pole S. 13° E. 120.55'

Set nail & spotter in S. side 4th wood fence post N. 50° E. 42.59'
