

- Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner: FOUND THE 1/2" BAR 5' SOUTH OF THE C/L OF COVERT ROAD. FOUND THE ASH N75°E, CITED BY YOUNG, BRYAN & HELSEL; FOUND THE 4" STEEL POST N40°E, CITED BY BRYAN; FOUND THE OAK N10°W, CITED BY YOUNG, BRYAN & HELSEL. THE 1/2" BAR WAS ON LINE WITH A FENCE TO THE NORTH AND 3' WEST OF VERY OLD CONCRETE FENCE POSTS TO THE SOUTH, EXCAVATED A 5' X 12' X 4' DEEP HOLE CONCENTRATING ON THE FENCE LINE TO THE SOUTH. FOUND A 4" X 18" PIECE OF CEDAR POST LYING DOWN, APPROXIMATELY 3' EAST OF YOUNG'S MARKER. THIS IS A FILLED SWAMP AREA AND AN 18" C.M.P. LIES UNDER COVERT ROAD APPROXIMATELY 6' EAST OF YOUNG'S MARKER.
