I, Gary L. Pisoni, in a field survey on Dec. 9, 1998 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and /or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established in October, 1851 by Guy H. Carleton, U.S. Deputy Surveyor.
Original Corner; Meander Post
Original Bearing Trees;

Aspen	10"	S 15°E	33 links (21.78 feet)
Aspen	8"	N 60°E	24 links (15.84 feet)

In 1981, Gary L. Pisoni RLS found a 1/2" diameter iron pipe, 4' from waters edge, located on the East shore of Indian Lake marking the East Meander corner position. Iron pipe set by unknown persons and has been used for various lot surveys along the East shore of said lake.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original B.T.s found. Found monument as described above.

The actual measured distance from the quarter corner to the East M.C. is not consistent with GLO distances in the area. There is an apparent error in the GLO distance along this line. The actual measured distance from the M.C. to the quarter corner is S 89°39'45"E, 2206.29 feet and the GLO distance from M.C. to quarter corner is East, 1863.84 feet.

I accept the above monument as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Replaced iron pipe with a 3/4" diameter aluminum rod monument, 3 feet long, with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped as follows:
Iron County Remonumentation, T42N, R33W, M.C., S-7, S-18, 1998, RLS 27457 from which I established the following bearing trees: (All measurements taken to a nail in side of tree, no B.T. signs or blazing of trees)
