

No evidence of original corner or bearing tree remains. Corner position found marked by a concrete plat monument. Plat monument being part of the Brady Estates sub-division of Caspian and also located at a fence corner. Replaced plat monument with an aluminum pipe monument as described below. | Monument is 2" below ground surface.

This corner is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
