### A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established in June, 1851 by Guy H. Carleton, U.S. Deputy Surveyor.

Original Corner; Wood Post

Original Bearing Trees:

Sugar	10"	S 54°W	12 links (7.92 feet)
Sugar	12"	N 31°E	31 links (20.46 feet)

### B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original B.T.s found.

Found a 3" diameter squared wood post marking corner position. Wood post is approximately 50 years old and the bearings and distances East, West, North, and South are consistent with GLO distances.

I accept the wood post as the best available evidence for restoring the corner position.

### C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position, set a 5/8" diameter by 30" long rebar, flush with ground surface, with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped as follows: Iron County Remonumentation, T44N, R33W, S-13, S-14, S-23, S-24, 2000, RLS 27457 from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees: (All measurements taken to a nail in side of tree)
