Gary L. Pisoni, in a field survey on November 30, 2000 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

Original corner established on August 6, 1846 by Austin Burt, U.S. Deputy Surveyor.

Original Corner; Black Ash Post

Original Bearing Trees:

Fir	6"	S 62 1/2° E	28 links (18.48 feet)
Hemlock	8"	N 60° W	27 links (17.82 feet)

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

No evidence of original B.T.s found.

Found an old fence line 12' South of the corner position and running approximately East and West, no apparent fence corner marking corner position.

Restored the corner position by single proportionate measurement and on line between the Northeast and Southeast Section corners of Section 25.

Corner record research on file with County Representative.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

At the corner position, set a 5/8" diameter by 30" long rebar, flush with ground surface, with a 3" diameter aluminum cap stamped as follows: Iron County Remonumentation, T44N, R33W, R32W, 1/4, S-25, S-30, 2000, RLS 27457 from which I established the following new blazed and scribed bearing trees: (All measurements taken to a nail in side of tree)

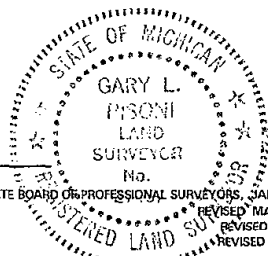
