- b.) Quarter corner common to Sections 14 and 23. 1852 Established by Francis Houck, U.S. Deputy. Set post midway and on the Section line between Section corners 40.00 ch. east and west. Maple 10" N40°E 10 links, Sugar 12* S27°W 24 links. Northern Paper Mills records: 1931 Buell and Ellison found both B.T.s. Set post. 1954 Wickman and Peryam found post 16" Sugar S27°W 24 links rotted out face. Red Maple N40°E 10 links down rotting. Iron marks faint. Set pipe with brass cap from B.T.

Part B: Surveyor's Report on Perpetuation, Restoration, Reestablishment, or Monumentation of Corner

- a.) The original post and accessories were not recovered. At a position consistent with the original record, I found a old 1-1/4" ID iron pipe. Did not observe any existing witness trees. I accepted the position of the pipe as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.
- b.) Found the 1954 monument in good condition and at record bearing and distance from the 1954 witnesses, now both rotted stumps. Accepted the position of the monument as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
