# Part A: Corner History

### E7 - corner common to sections 16 17 20 & 21 T25N R6W E6 - 1/4 corner common to sections 16 & 17, T25N, R6W

- 1852 GLO Cannon set post corner of sects. 16, 17,
   20 & 21
  - 1) Y Pine 12" S64°E 50. 2) sp. Pine 8" N44°W 57.
- 1912 Fargo Engineering Map #3413 and field notes Found two very old stakes from which old Y. Pine which seems to have been marked for witness bears S76E 44 links instead of 50 links. Accepted stakes as corner. – Set iron & crockery corner with raised picket & U.S. flag. Took witnesses which bears –
  - 3) sp. Pine stub 9" S72°E 1.693/4.
  - 4) sp. Pine stub 12" N84°30'W 1.221/2.
- 1940 Marcus Schaaf field notes found NW BT site and bole and SE BT site where tree was tipped over. This cor. was located after discovering the old effaced corner 3.24 ch East and 5.50 ch South, where the NW BT Bole with both faces was found and also SE site and bole plain.-

Corner had been previously located and perpetuated by Marcus Schaaf, Registered Land Surveyor. Remains of one original B.T. stil in place, in poor condition. - 1" pipe with 4" brass cap. -

## Part B: Surveyor's Report on Perpetuation, Restoration, Reestablishment, or Monumentation of Corner

#### E7 – corner common to sections 16 17 20 & 21 T25N R6W E6 – ¼ corner common to sections 16 & 17, T25N, R6W

Found 4" department of conservation brass cap on 1" pipe. Also found Fargo 1" pipe. Fargo notes that he found stakes, while Schaaf notes say he found the two GLO accessories. The Schaaf position was updated to a department of conservation monument in 1954. Accepted the position of the found 4" department of conservation brass cap on 1" pipe as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.

Found 4" department of conservation brass cap on 1" pipe. Found stump of accessory #9 fitting position of monument. Accepted found 4" department of conservation brass cap on 1" pipe as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
