A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

M13 - corner common to section 36, T25N R7W, section 31, T25N R6W, section 1 T24N R7W, & section 6 T24N R6W

- 1839 GLO GLO survey of township lines by John Brink set a post for the corner of T24&25N, R6&7W 1) Beech 10" S29°E 20; 2) Beech 10" N69½°W 17.
- 1940 Marcus Schaaf field notes Int. town corner 1.94 ch S of post. Set this in accordance with line tree and ¼ corner East. 3) Wh Pine Stump 24" N41½°E 49; 4) Wh Pine stump 34" S15½°E 63; 5) Wh Pine stump 32" S61½°W 61; 6) W. Pine stub 30"x15' N52°W 1.17. A corner is set and NBT'd 182S & 24E of true corner.
- 1955 DNR Corner Record Kenneth Ostling, PS #10068 this corner was found by forestry division survey crew while making a partial resurvey of this township. Corner was previously established by Marcus Schaaf, registered Land Surveyor in 1940, from identified line tree and ¼ corner East. 1" pipe with 4" Brass Cap. –

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:

M13 - corner common to section 36, T25N R7W, section 31, T25N R6W, section 1 T24N R7W, & section 6 T24N R6W

Found 4" brass DOC monument on 1" pipe and one witness per the 1955 DNR corner record. Found pine stumps (#3) & (#4) from Schaaf survey fitting the position of the monument. S6°15'22"E 121.47' from DOC monument found a 2½" X 1.5' long pinched pipe in 6" X 14" concrete as noted by Schaaf, and is not utilized in this survey. The found 4" brass DOC monument on 1" pipe is accepted as a careful and faithful reestablishment of the position of the original corner.
