

1901 - CSR - W.S. Merrill, Bk. 20, P. 67, shows corner.

1987 - Certificate of Survey, L.3, P.127 - E. Farrier, PS #24594. Set 1/2" rod & cap.

2 - E1/16 corner common to sections 16 & 21.

1959 - DNR Corner record - K. J. Ostling, PS #10068. This corner was established by proportionate measurement by Forestry Division survey crew while making a partial resurvey of this township. Set 1" X 24" pipe. 9" Cedar N13°E 46 Links. 10" Cedar N35°W 63 Links.

- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- 2-E 1/16 corner common to sections 17 & 20.

Found 1/2" X 18" rebar and cap per Farrier Certificate of Survey. Found no county surveyor evidence. Replaced found 1/2" X 18" rebar and cap with a stamped 2" Aluminum cap on 5/8" x 34" rebar.

2 - E 1/16 corner common to Sections 16 & 21.

Ostling pipe not found. Calculated Ostling position not used because remonumentation rejected the position of G7 Ostling used to establish the corner. Set a stamped 2" aluminum cap on 5/8" X 34" rebar per BLM standard procedure, using the remonumentation position of G7.
