do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Professional Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

- 1829 Corner post established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor G. Risdon "Int. N. boundary of twp. 66 lks. East of post. Set post at intersection". Beech 7in S48°W 12 lk. Beech 7in S64°E 25 lks.  
1866 F. Stimson "Sec. cor. lost. Established by bisecting 2 miles on town line - stake & stone at corner- also stake and stone 2 rds. south".  
1878 E. Strong (stone) Apple 4 SE. 40½ Apple 4 SW. 49½  
Date ? KCRC witness notes: Sidestone South 32.82' 12" Maple S30°W 30.24' WEL S60°W 92.56'

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original corner and accessories not recovered.

Found 1 "X7½" iron pipe directly over State of Michigan brass plate on post. State mon. is surrounded by stones. State mon. is stamped: "State of Michigan Section corner Sec.5 / Sec. 4 T1S R11W Unlawful to Move or Destroy This Marker"  
Did not find stone 33' south. Road has been cut 4' -5' from natural ground.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

E1, Northeast corner Section 5, T2S, R11W, Ratified by kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on June 15, 1995 as a closing corner. State Monument location is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Set 20" Harrison Monument over State Monument in Mon. box.

Set P.K. nail in E. side 33" Maple S30°W 30.19'  
Set P.K. nail in 22" Maple N30°E 38.87'
