A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1826 - Corner established by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Robert Clark, Jr.: "Intersected W. boundary 88 lks, South of post. Set post at intersection corner to sections 30 and 31. Wh. Oak 12 in N 29 ° E Wh. Oak 17 in S 70 ° E 32 lks.

1872 - F. Hodgman: "Corner stone of former survey Poplar 8 N 45 ° W 75 Y. Oak 5 S 80 ° W 56 1/2"

1875 - F. Hodgman: "Set marked stone 88 lks, South of the Pavilion corner,"

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Original corner and accessories not recovered. No surface marker found. Found 1 inch diameter lead pipe in concrete. Pipe in concrete is 40" +/- long at a depth of 2.5 feet below road surface. Found no stone. Excavated a 4' x 4' x 6' deep hole. Removed concrete monument in order to seach for stone. No stone found. Concrete monument measures 58.26 feet South of the found Harrison monument at Pavilion corner M11.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

A11, Northwest Corner of Section 31, Town 3 South, Range 9 West. Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Peer Group on September 23, 1999. The position of the pipe in concrete is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner. Set a 20" Harrison Monument in a monument box in place of the pipe in concrete.
