A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:  
Corner post set by U.S. Deputy Surveyor Robert Clark, Jr. in 1826.  
Accessories: Lynn 10" S77°E 37 lks. Beech 10" N10°E 45 lks.  
1861 F. Stimson accessories: Red Oak 6" N88°W 59½ lks. Swamp Oak 15" N58½°E 73 lks.  
1873 Survey by Ed Strong "Stone - evidence slight but exceedingly satisfactory".  
1883 F. Hodgeman "Measured from bearing tree of F. Stimson's resurvey and found old stake in  
place. Set a 3' earthen post even with surface of ground".  
1993 I.W.M. Inc.: Set capped iron midway between E1/4 cor. sec. 18 and E1/4 cor. sec. 19 and  
39.27' (59½ lks.) S79°30'E from 42" Oak.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:  
Original corner with accessories not recovered.

Found I.W.M. Inc. capped iron.

Found earthen post (tile) with cap and drill hole 9' below existing asphalt road. Tile is  
0.4' west and 5.3' north of I.W.M. Inc. iron. Tile is surrounded by five 4" - 8" stones,  
broken brick, and ashes.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

C7 Corner of sections 17, 18, 19, and 20, T.3S., R.9W.

Found earthen post (tile) with cap and drill hole 9' below existing asphalt road. Tile is  
surrounded by five 4" - 8" stones, broken brick, and ashes. Tile is assumed to be same as  
set by F. Hodgeman in 1883 and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the  
original corner position. Placed 30" Harrison monument over tile and set monument box over mon..

Accessories: Fnd. nail in east face of 42" Oak N80°W 36.83'  
Fnd. P.K. nail in SEly. face 11" Oak S52°W 45.47'  
Set P.K. nail in N. face 14" Basswood N55°W 53.43'  
NE. Cor. inlet casting S38°W 44.72'
