A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1826: United States Government Surveyors; set 1/4 Section post.

Beech 7" S. 44° W. 9 lks.  
Beech 5" S. 73° E. 10 lks.

1883: F. Hodgman, County Surveyor; "Found stake standing at angle of fence, N. 44° E. 9 lks. from stump of Beech bearing tree. Bored 3 ft. in stake hole, filled the bottom with stone and put 2 ft. earthen post over and noted for bearing trees, Maple 6" S. 80° W. 55 lks., and Beech 20" N. 15° E. 37½ lks."

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1975: Larkin Winther, RLS #13605; Survey in SW 1/4 and SE 1/4, Section 14 and perhaps set iron for E 1/4 post.

1992: Wilkins & Wheaton Engr. Co.; Found iron at East 1/4 post, Section 14.  
in center line Road South & East 8" W. Cherry N. 45° E. 37.3'  
22" Ash S. 40° W. 61.8' Large Stone North 2.0'

1997: Found 3" round tile down 10" below surface. Dug to 20" and found good section of tile. Large stone East 1.86' and in approximate intersection of Roads East and South. Iron to Southwest 2.37'

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K-06: West 1/4 post, Section 13, T. 3 S., R. 9 W., ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on June 19, 1997 and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Found 3" round tile set in 1883 Remonumentation Survey by F. Hodgman, County Surveyor. Placed 20" Harrison Monument over tile.
