I, Robert E. Snell, in a field survey on June 6, 1997 do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law, established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1826: United States Government Surveyors: Set $\frac{1}{4}$ Section post
Sugar 12" S. 76° W. 28 lks.
Sugar 8" S. 62° E. 27 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks.

1883: F. Hodgman, County Surveyor: "Found stone of former survey, removed it and planted 3 ft. earthen post 4" below surface. Highest point of a large boulder containing about two cubic yards sunk mostly below surface is about N. 50° E., 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. distance. The same boulder was former witness to corner but has been sunk since resurvey of 1869."

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1997: Found $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" iron with rocks around and a 3" x 4" piece of tile 6" below surface of the road. Tile piece laying on its side. Removed rocks and dug to 25" and found good section of tile. Noted railroad rail fence corners West 27.2' and N. 48° E., 39.4'.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K-10: West $\frac{1}{4}$ post, Section 25, T. 3 S., R. 9 W., ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on August 21, 1997 and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Found 3" round tile 25" below surface of road under $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18" iron rod. Tile was set by F. Hodgman, County Surveyor in 1883 Remonumentation survey. Removed iron rod and set 20" Harrison monument over tile with monument box.
