A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration.  
1826: United States Government Surveyors: Set 1/4 Section Post.

Beech 30" South 10 1/2 lks.  
Beech 8" N. 44° E., 19 lks.

1872: Samuel Hodgman, Deputy County Surveyor: " Found stake verified by trace of witnesses and set stone with "+" and marked:

Sugar 14" N. 78 1/2° W. 46 lks.  
Beech 10" S. 63 1/2° W. 42 1/2 lks.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

1968: Wilkins & Wheaton Engineering Co.: Found stone (1' x 1' x 12") with "+" on top, bent over. Reset stone from 38" Beech, S. 63°-30'-W, 27.94'.

14" Spruce N.-66°-45'-W, 52.60', NE corner house N-83°-26'-W., 109.70'  
12" Red Cedar S.-50°-53'-W, 51.5', 18" Maple N.-42°-48'-E., 30.00'  
36" Maple S.-21°-58'-E, 74.0', 12" Phone Pole S.-89°-04'-E., 23.8'

1997: Found stone (1' x 1' x 2') with "+" down about 9" with monument box over noted 14" spruce, NE corner of house (now different), 18" Maple and stump of 36" Maple as well as 1872 witness Beech 10" now 50".

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner.

E-10: West 1/4 Post, Section 28, T. 4 S., R. 9 W., ratified by Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on September 18, 1997 and is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the original corner. Found stone (1' x 1' x 2') with "+" as set in 1872 by S. Hodgman, Deputy County Surveyor and reset in 1968. Lowered stone and placed 20" Harrison monument over stone and placed monument box (without lid) over monument.
