A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

This Position Not Established by Original Government Surveyors.

1904: Ed Strong, County Surveyor; Set iron at 40 Lks East of South 1/4 Post for Section 32, Pavilion Township.

1931: Wilkins & Wheaton Engineering Company; Used 26.40' East of South 1/4 Post for Section 32, Pavilion Township (no mention of found or set).

1987: Ingersoll, Watson and McMachen; Set iron 26.40' East of South 1/4 Post for Section 32, Pavilion Township.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1994: Found 1/2" x 20" Iron at surface of Road. Believed to be set by Ingersoll, Watson and McMachen. Found 2 plow points below iron laying flat. Found another iron 3/4" in diameter below plow points.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

D-1 North 1/4 Post Section 5, T. 4 S., R. 10 W., Ratified by the Kalamazoo County Remonumentation Program Peer Group on September 15, 1994. Found 3/4" iron below 2 plow points and iron, as set by Ed Strong in 1904 survey. This position not established by original government surveyors. This monument is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the corner. Removed iron at the surface and placed a 20" Harrison monument over 3/4" iron, placed plow points beside monument and placed a monument box over.
