I, Allen H. McMachen, in a field survey on August 28, 19 97, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Professional Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 4 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

1829 - E. H. Lytle, D.S., Set quarter Sec. post in prairie and raised mound.

1873 - Ed Strong, C.S., "U.S. Standing"

1879 - F. Hodgman, C.S., "At proportional distances between Section corners 1 & 4 (in Sec. 1) on true line, set stone with brick around".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found nail & tab in pavement. Dug and found iron in mon. box with no lid. Removed iron & box and found a basketball size stone directly under about 1.5' below grade. Stone was surrounded by red brick. Nail & Tab, iron in box and stone were all at same position.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found stone is accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner. Placed Harrison Monument over stone with monument box over, Accessories:

Railroad rail fence post East 28.8'

Nail & Tab in S.W. side of 20" Cottonwood S. 30° E. 47.9'

Nail & Tab in South side P. Pole N. 80° W. 52.4'

Fence corner West 88.1'
