

I, <u>Craig W. McVean</u>, in a field survey on <u>Oct. 22</u>, 2013 do hereby state that under requirements of PA 74, Michigan PA of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

- A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:
- 7 1975 LCRC L. C002, p. 246 C. F. Roser Set 1 ¼" x 30" pipe and cedar post with location tag. 1) 9" Cedar N32°W 33.0' 2) 12" White Pine N88°E 33.5' Centerline N-S grade East 13'
- $\underline{9}$ 1976 Unrecorded Survey Lake State Surveying file #2588 76 C. E. Cole (PS #17615) iron set
- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- 7 N 1/16 Corner common to Sections 21 & 22 -. Found 1 ¼" inside diameter iron pipe per Roser & stumps of both witnesses. Centerline of N-S overgrown 2-Track is East 14'±. 1 ¼" iron pipe accepted as best available evidence of the position of the corner.
- 9 CE 1/16 Corner Section 21 Found ¾" outside diameter pipe at corner of E & S 10' high deer fence. This may be Cole's position but it did not fit his survey dimension to the East, so rejected it. Set stamped 2" Aluminum cap epoxied on 8" cabin spike set in Large Red Maple root, per Standard BLM procedure. Measured Grid distance east of 1317.95' (1317.75' C. Cole) to 'G8'. The rejected ¾" pipe is S88°45′E 2.09'.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- 7 1 1/2" inside diameter iron pipe N75°W 5.86' to set N & T in N. side 7" Oak N23°E 11.09' to set N & T in W. side 4" White Pine East 31.21' to set N & T in N. side 5" White Pine S24°W 35.11' to set N & T in W. side 12" Cedar Reset Cedar post with location tag 1' North Set Blue Composite Post with location tag 1' NW

9 - Stamped 2" Aluminum Cap epoxied on 8" cabin spike in Root of 26" R. Maple S88°45'E 2.09' to found ¾" iron pipe N19°W 14.04' to set N & T in W. side 22" Red Maple S42°W 2.16' to set N & T in E. side 26" Red Maple N69°W 37.13' to set N & T in S. side twin 8" Red Maple N12°E 31.52' to set N & T in E. side 13" Red Maple East 3' to Corner 10' high Deer Fence S & E Set Blue Composite Post with location tag 1.9' NW
