## SUMMARY H-11

NORTH 1/4 CORNER, SECTION 34, T1N-R5E HAMBURG TOWNSHIP, LIVINGSTON COUNTY, MICHIGAN.

Found a 4" pipe in swamp by utilizing measurements on Clay Gordon Survey Page 11 of this Dossier. Made sweep of area and also found concrete monument 3.50 feet Southwesterly. There is no fence or occupation and the area is open for G.P.S..

On September 4, 1923, H. H. Atwell platted "Strawberry Point Bluff" see Page 22. On February 13, 1924, Clay Gordon platted "Pine Bluff Annex" see Page 23.

Clay Gordon's September 1930 Survey on Page 11 denotes Irons 17.87 feet and 40 feet North of North 1/4 Corner which Boss Engineering found on 10-12-1994. This distance agrees with previous plats. On July 20, 1956, Huron Clinton Metropolitan Authority Survey Page 13 found 2" I.P.. On December 11, 1975 Boss Engineering Survey pages 15, 16 and 20 found 4" pipe and Witnesses to second pipe 17.93 feet North of 1/4 Corner.

On January 17, 1978 Neree D. Alix Act 74 on Page 18 describes South 1/4 Corner of Section 27 as a round iron bar (no witnesses found).

Distances from the North 1/4 Corner of Section 34 to the Northeast Corner of said Section by 5 different Surveyors can be found on Page 6 of this Dossier.

Conclusion: We find the distance measured Southerly (17.87 feet) from two plat dimensions and Clay Gordon 1930 Survey call the 4" pipe as found the North 1/4 Corner of Section 34.
