

## SUMMARY M-2

East 1/4 Corner, Section 1, Brighton Township.

G.L.O. Notes record neither the East 1/4 Corner nor the Southeast Corner of Section 1 were ever set. The notes also record measurements logged North to South. (see page 5 of dossier for sketch of GLO measurements)

Found 1 inch x 2 ft. pointed shaft at base of wood post. Reset disturbed shaft on East side of post. Fence remnants found North-South and West. Boss Engineering ran G.P.S. through this point.

The Warner and Warner survey in 1954 refers to this corner and many accesory corners. This map shows all Corners from M-1 through M-7 and is the only survey of substance in this area. Boss ran the entire "M" line thru the GM Proving Grounds and found that the measurement from M-1 to M-7 is within 0.60 feet from the distance computed on the Warner survey.

The Midwestern Consulting survey of 1988 appears to be a control survey within the limits of the GM proving Grounds. This survey appears to use the Warner Survey of 1954 as its basis but does not retrace any of the Warner survey along the "M" line of Brighton Township (Note that all of the computed measurements of this survey match the Warner Survey).

We find that the distances to M-1 and to the iron in the Mon Box in Commerce Road match the Warner survey.

We reccomend using the existing point, as found, for M-2.
