WE FOUND A 1/2" IRON ROD WITH THE REMAINS OF AN OLD FENCE TO THE NORTH, SOUTH, EAST AND WEST. THE IRON WAS SURROUNDED BY A STEEL PIPE AND A SEEL FENCE POST.

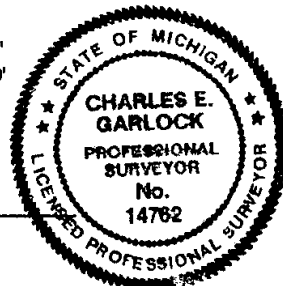
