### A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

#### I-8 Common 1/4 Corner, Sections 22 & 23, T4N-R4E, Cohoctah Township, Livingston County

In 1823, a wood post was placed by Sylvester Sibley, Deputy Surveyor, and two witness trees were marked, S75E 52 links 13" B. Oak and S54W 9 links 10" W. Oak.

In 1919, a survey by G.H. Dunning, County Surveyor, no object or witnesses are listed.

In 1973, an Act 132 Certified Survey by Karol R. Piotrowski, #9685, set 1/2" iron midway and online, lists two witnesses, one of which was recovered.

In 1973, an Act 74 form filed by Karol R. Piotrowski, #9685, lists same information as Act 132.

In 1993, an unrecorded survey by Charles Garlock, #14762, shows corner on sketch, no object or witnesses are listed.

In 1994, an unrecorded survey by Charles Garlock, #14762, calls for 1/2" iron rod and lists four witnesses, three of which were recovered.

### B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

#### I-8 Common 1/4 Corner, Sections 22 & 23, T4N-R4E, Cohoctah Township, Livingston County

Found no evidence of original government corner. Found 1/2" iron rod on South end of tree line running North, 13' ± West of West line of corn field to the East and 400' ± North of tree line running East. Verified the position of the found rod with witnesses and measurements from 1973 to the present. Found no conflicting evidence in the vicinity of this position. We recommend that the found 1/2" iron rod be accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original government corner and be replaced with a standard Livingston County monument with brass cap and carsonite post.

#### I-8 Common 1/4 Corner, Sections 22 & 23, T4N-R4E, Cohoctah Township, Livingston County

Set standard Livingston County monument with brass cap stamped "I-8 39096".

N05W 47.06' Set nail with Livingston County Survey Witness Tag in West face of a 14" Choke Cherry

S05W 56.18' North face of 4" Gas line marker

S45W 165.45' Set nail with Livingston County Survey Witness Tag in North face of South pole of E-W main power pole

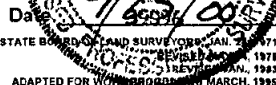
N10W 28.55' Found nail with "Hughes #19834" tag in West face of 6" Ash

S75W 61.30' Set nail with Livingston County Survey Witness Tag in South face of 10" Cherry
