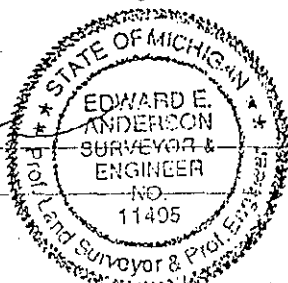

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SUMMARY

April 4, 1995

K-6 WEST 1/4 CORNER OF SECTION 13, T4N-R5E, DEERFIELD TOWNSHIP
LIVINGSTON COUNTY, MICHIGAN.

Found 1/2" rerod in the centerline of Green Road (gravel)

Checked and measured to witnesses we found. Found 2 of 3 of Benton witnesses, and they checked, page 10 this dossier.

Distance from the West 1/4 corner to the N.W. corner of said Section 13 is 2662.01' as measured in the field by E.E. Anderson on 4/3/95, page 6 this dossier.

Distance from the West 1/4 corner to the S.W. corner of said Section 13 is 2669.94' on Benton Survey, page 9 this dossier.

Made a clean sweep of the immediate area and found no additional corners or irons.

Gravel road running north and south, flat in both directions.

Terrain is open to the east and wooded to the west. Old fence and tree line running east and west.

Area is not good for G.P.S.

Came to the conclusion that the 1/2" rerod we found is the correct West 1/4 corner of said Section 13.
