Corner set in 1815 by Alex Holmes. The G.L.O. Map records 115.5 feet at Township jog. The August 5, 1969 survey by Munsell & Garlock records iron pipe found and witnesses logged (no previous surveys or witnesses to establish creation of this iron were found).

On June 19, 1987, Delta Land Surveying found 3/4 inch pipe and recorded 116.43 foot jog to A-7.

WITNESSES

On August 1, 1988, Griffels - Webster found iron pipe and two witnesses checked Charles Garlock September 27, 1968 witnesses.

Garlock survey of September 27, 1968 found 3/4" pipe Richard F. Frank and James H. Miller also found 3/4 inch iron pipes in 1992 and 1993. Witnesses verifed and checked by Boss on December 27, 1996, and found 3/4 inch pipe at surface of gravel road. The pipe was straightened and reset 1/2 foot deep.
