1913 E. E. Sours, County Surveyor, Wexford County (See Book 2, Pages 57 and 58) restored corner by single proportionate measurement, (2627 feet feet from M-11 and M-13). Monument not noted, no references.

Restored location of corner by projecting line North 27.6 feet from "POB" iron and on line with M-13 (SE corner of Section 36). The distance South to M-13 is 2626.13 feet and the distance North to M-11 is 2622.89 feet. The is position measured 0.66 feet East of a straight line between M-11 and M-13.
