- B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or re-establishing corner:
- E2 1/4 Corner common to Sections 4 & 5, T14N, R1W Excavated corner location based on retracement of Gibbs' survey. At 1' down found old gravel road bed. At 1.8' down found nest of crockery around top of definite stake shadow 3"± in diameter. 5 pieces of crockery on S. side and 2 pieces on N. side. Traced stake shadow to good point down 3.2' into white sand layer. No evidence of GLO BT's but fits Gibbs' survey as follows: S0°28'34"W 2623.72' – Grid (2640' – GLO, S36'W 2626.8' – FJG) to 'E3' and N0°33'42"E 2784.99'- Grid (2793.78' - GLO, N38'E 2789.16' - FJG) to 'E1'. Stake shadow in line with old road bed south. Centerline traveled 2-track to East is 6'± South. Down fence remains to west. Stake shadow and crockery accepted as a careful and faithful perpetuation of the position of the original corner.
 - Reference Point Fd. Ledy's 5/8" iron rod N66°47'W 2.94' from 'E2'. The 1989 LCRC per Ledy is in error. The monument and witnesses for 'E2' are for 'C2' and his monument and witnesses for 'C2' are really for 'E2'. This is confirmed by Ledy's notes obtained from Apex Surveying. 5/8" rod in conflict with historical Gibbs and GLO position and is not utilized as 'E2' in this survey.
- C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:
- E2 Set stamped 4" DNR Aluminum Cap on 1" x 36" long galv. iron pipe with 4" x 1' long PVC pipe with concrete around cap at found stake shadow. Place the found pieces of crockery at base of monument as a memorial. Set Blue Carsonite Post with loc. tag 10' West
