Part A: Corner(s) History

- E13 & E1 – 1830 – GLO – R. Clark, Jr. – Set Post
- Pine 36" N43°E 70 L.
 - Aspen 5" N78°W 47 L.
- 1852 – GLO Subdivision T15N, R1W – A. Burt
- S0°39'W Correcting between Sec. 4 & 5
- Aspen 5" S61°E 26 L.
 - Aspen 10" S65°W 61 L.

Part B: Surveyor's Report on Perpetuation or Monumentation of Corner(s)

E13 & E1 – Standard corner common to Section 32 & 33, T16N, R1W and Sec. 4 & 5, T15N, R1W – No GLO evidence found. Could not find any remains of large pine stump. Set stamped 4" DNR Aluminum cap on 1" x 36" galvanized iron pipe by single proportion on the line of parallel between 'C1 – C13' and 'I1 – I13'. Measured east 330' ± to east edge of old channel of Mud Creek (5 chains stream 19 SE – GLO). DNR monument accepted as a careful and faithful re-establishment of the position of the original corner.

E13 & E1 – Stamped 4" DNR aluminum cap on 1" x 36" long galvanized iron pipe. Set blue composite post 1' South

S01°E 58.56' to set nail & tag in west side 8" Oak scribed 'XBT'
N80°W 12.95' to centerline of 1" Oak at blaze
