Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

K-7, T5S, R9E, Ash Township. Monroe County - ID No. 58 Section Corner Common to Sections 13, 14, 23 & 24 (Ready Road - Tarby over 8 inch stone over 3 inch gravel)

1817, G.L.O. Joseph Fletcher set post corner of Sections 13, 14, 23 & 24; witnesses: Lyme 12 (inch) N.36°W. 4 links, White Ash 9 (inch) S.33°W. 25 links. 1903, L.A. lloward, witnessed Burr Oak 20 inch North 71° East 1.26 chains, Sugar Maple 8 inch South 40 1/4° East 57 1/2 links. Monroe County Road Commission road plans for Ready Road, Sheet 3, indicates a corner stone being 3.1 feet south of survey centerline station 157+93.3. 1962, Ray Graf 1962 witnesses for M.D.O.T. 1974, Gary Stanley recorded L.C.R.C., Liber 2, Page 43, as iron pipe. Various surveyors used an iron 4 foot +/- south of stone accepted by L.A. Howard and noted in road survey. June 1992, we recovered the stone and recorded L.C.R.C., Liber 3, Page 228, as K-7.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

K-7 - 10/24/1994, found 3/4 inch X 12 inch iron pipe over high point of granite (red) stone. Dug a 18 inch X 24 inch hole, found two smaller granite (red) stones, one east and one west of stone, under found 3/4 inch X 12 inch iron pipe. Removed stones found no post, probed in all directions found no further stones. Set a 1 inch X 36 inch iron pipe, replacing stone & iron pipe, placed all stones around pipe, inside monument box at surface and witnessed as shown below. 11/15/94, set brass remonumentation cap on 1 inch x 36 inch iron pipe inside monument box.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

K-7 - Set 1 inch X 36 inch iron pipe with brass remonumentation cap inside monument box to replace stone and iron pipe and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner and Witnesses:

South 10° West 3.88 feet to found 1 inch iron pipe

North 60° Fast 80.2 feet to found P.K./shiner south of southeast side utilities pole

North 10° Fast 22.46 feet to southwest corner of concrete slab

North 5° West 110.3 feet to northeast corner of residence No. 3046
