

15: Not established in 1937 Gio survey by heah Brookfield. County Surveyor Daoust reports setting an area claushed and stone for this corner in 1906 and witnesses an Only 3, NOAW, 50 Bloks.

## B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner.

- 10: Found flat iron and crockery and 1906 hearing tree, now 30° diameter and dead. Flat iron is 0.65 west of line between C12 and C15 and 0.9 south of split. Accested flat iron as corner.
- 15: Danust's monument and Bi were not found. Established corner mid-way and on line between C15 and D13.


