I, GERALD W. CARLSON, in a field survey on Wednesday, December 6, 1995, do hereby certify that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Professional Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, re-monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

M-11/12: Meander Corner North of the Quarter Corner common to Section 36, T48N-R27W and Section 31, T48N-R26W. 1844: Austin Burt's original survey notes describe the corner monument as a wood post referenced by:
10" Tamarack N03W, 21 l

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

1995: Original Meander Corner falls in Teal Lake. Set a Witness Corner grouted in rock 150.00' North of the prorated calculated Meander Corner on line between the N.E. and S.E. Corners of Section 36. Distance North is 1787.43' and Distance South is 3457.70'.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

1995: Set a 3/4" X 12" rebar, grouted in rock, and capped with a 3 1/4" aluminum tablet Marquette County Survey Monument, 0.15' above ground, and stamped to identify the corner. Established references using duplex nails set in:

15" W. Pine	N46E,	66.45'
7" W. Pine	N11W,	26.41'
7" W. Pine	N81W,	31.11'
16" W. Pine	S62W,	58.53'
Green Steel Fence Post w/Survey Monument Sign	N85E,	2.16'
