A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration: F-13: South Quarter Corner of Section 33, T49N-R26W.

No subsequent record evidence recovered.

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

F-13: 2000: SCA survey crews conducted a thorough search of the area and found a ½" rebar placed next to a 3' high squared wood post. Blue paint lines running East and West were also noted.. Line calls East and West matched in some instances but not in others. Corner position was established on the latitudinal curve by single proportionate measurement between the Southeast Corner of Section 31, T49N-R26W and the Southeast corner of Section 36, T49N-R26W. Corner position lands in stream so a Witness Monument was set on line between the SW corner of Section 33 and the calculated S 1/4 corner position 60.00' horizontal distance West of the calculated 1/4 corner position.
