I, Stephan J. Szyszkoski, in a field survey on _____, 19____ do hereby state that under requirements of P.A. 74, Michigan P.A. of 1970, the corner points mentioned in lines 1 and 2 above were in conformance with regulations and rules therefore as required in the current manual of survey instructions of the United States Department of the Interior, Bureau of Land Management or by a decree of a Court of Law and/or that the corner points mentioned in lines 3, 4 and 5 above were in conformance with the rules of the Michigan Board of Land Surveyors or by a Decree of a Court of Law; established, re-established, monumented, recovered, found as expressed below:

NOTE: Not more than 2 corners, all in the same town and range, may be recorded on this certificate.

A. Description of original monument and accessories and/or subsequent restoration:

(F13) Quarter corner on the South Side of Section 33. Original corner established in 1845 by Austin Burt: "40.00 Set qr. section post. Sugar 16 N35E 07, Sugar 8 N71W 33".

B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

(F13) Original post and accessories not recovered. Found no acceptable evidence of the position of the original corner on the ground. Reestablished the corner on the Fifth Correction Line at the proportionate North Latitude between monumented corners at E13 and H13, 2623.82' East of E13 and 5247.65' West of H13, being proportionate to the original record. At the position for the corner, I placed a 1"IDx36" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum MDNR tablet, appropriately stamped. From the corner monumented, the Northwest corner of T50N-R28W is westerly, 63.36'.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

(F13) Set 1" pipe with 4" MDNR cap.
Blazed and scribed the following new bearing trees:

16" Sugar N37W 7.1' "1/4S NBT"
7" Hemlock N45E 10.9' "1/4S NBT"
6" Ironwood S40E 30.5' "1/4S NBT"
5" Sugar S06W 23.5' "1/4S NBT"

Bearings are magnetic.

MDNR monuments are 1"IDx32" iron pipe capped with a 4" dia. cast aluminum Michigan Department of Natural Resources tablet, stamped with Township, Range, corner ID, date of placement, and "PS 33986".

New bearing trees are marked with a 8H blaze and a lower blaze at the root crown. The blazes are scribed as indicated in quotation marks at left, with NBT or BT (as noted) being on the lower blaze. Distances are horizontal (unless noted) and measured from the corner to the inside of a notch cut into the bottom of the lower blaze.
