B. Description of corner evidence found and/or method applied in restoring or reestablishing corner:

Found $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Brass cap on 2" Iron Pipe 46.6 feet West of old fence running South, and 26.7 feet South of centerline of Elmwood Road. This corner was perpetuated by George B. Wilson, RLS 17607, in 1976. Mr. Wilson found a 1" dia. Iron Pipe and an old wood stake at this location, which he states he believes to be 50 to 70 years old. This corner was previously recorded in Book 1 of Land Corner Records on page 140, and is accepted as the best available evidence of the position of the original corner.

C. Description of monument for corner and accessories established to perpetuate locating the position of the corner:

Found 2" dia. Iron Pipe/ $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Brass Cap stamped for corner:
